



Exports

- Export-oriented economy
- Dependent on the shipments of raw material (50 % of total) and manufactured goods (36 %).
- Main exports:
 - soybeans and related soy products (17%l
 - transport equipment and components (12 %)
 - Oil and oil products (13 %).
- Main destinations:
- China: 27 %
- U.S.: 12 %
- Argentina: 6 %
- Netherlands: 5 %
- Chile: 3 %

Trade Surpluses

EMBRAER

- From 2001 to 2012 and 2015 to 2017 Brazil has reported trade surpluses, primarily due to high export of mining and agricultural products.
- In 2018, the biggest trade surpluses were reported with China, the Netherlands, Argentina, Chile, Iran and Spain while the largest trade deficits were recorded with Germany, South Korea, Russia, Switzerland Algeria and France.


